- **Buying a Small Computer.** Published by the American Consulting Engineers Council, it contains 1980 ECAN articles and supplements from early 1981. It covers small computer technology (past, present and future), applications, step-by-step details of justification through installation and use. Appendices include comparisons of all computer sizes, purchasing resources, and a glossary.
